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HISTORIAL WARSAW



The Old Town and The Royal Way of Warsaw with its unrepeatable character makes them one of the "must see" spots for tourists visiting the capital of Poland. This is the very place where the second oldest constitution in the world was proclaimed and where numerous kings were crowned. The Old Town is an outstanding example of the old Warsaw architecture, with narrow streets, beautiful houses and palaces surrounded by the medieval city walls.

JEWISH WARSAW



There are approximately 96% of catholics living in Poland nowadays. Before the outbreak of the Second World War about 30% of Warsaw population was of Jewish origin. What happened to them? As soon as the Second World War ended Warsaw started to be rebuilt mostly as a model example of a city which would represent the spirit of social realism.
